

Requirements to Enter Kindergarten:

Social and Emotional Development

- Child is eager to learn
- Independence (Dressing, Eating, General Hygiene, Clean Up)
- Personal Facts (Full Name, Parents Names, Age)
- Respectful and obedient
- Sit still for short periods (15min+)
- Knows how to ask adults for help

Mathematics

- Counting (Verbally 1-10, Identify Numbers 1-10)
- Number Recognition and Sequencing (1-10)
- Sort by size, color, and shape
- Recognizes and copies simple patterns
- Shape Recognition (Square, Circle, Triangle, Rectangle)
- Identifies less/more between 2 groups

Reading

- Listening Skills (Follows 2-3 Step Directions, Retells Information)
Recite/Sing Alphabet
- Letter Recognition (Capital and Lowercase)
Concepts (Big/Little, Up/Down, First/Last, Like/Different ect.)

Physical Development

- Gross Motor Skills (Jumping, Running, Throwing, Catching)
- Fine Motor Skills (Controlled: Cutting, Drawing, Stacking, Taping, Gluing)

Writing

- Traces simple shapes (Straight Line, Square, Circle, Triangle)
- Traces letters
- Can draw and communicate using simple pictures and symbols

Art

- Recognize Colors (Black, White, Brown, Gray, Red, Yellow, Orange, Green, Blue, Purple, Pink)
- Pretend role play
- Music appreciation
