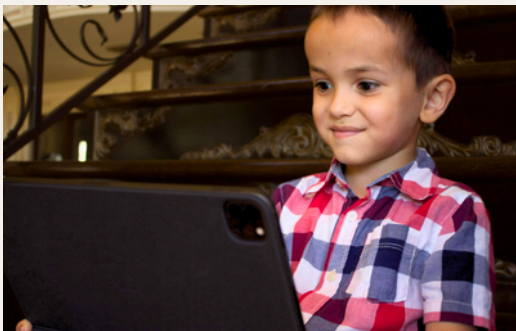


# Blue Manor Academy Fall 2026

### LEARN TO READ CLASS

Strengthen your knowledge of letter sounds and practice reading words with your friends! Enjoy some games and a story, and get help memorizing phonics sounds and blends. This Club is for ages 3-7. We will be following the Phonics curriculum in the Academy. We are excited to help your young children get motivated to read their first words!



### EARLY READER CLASS

Strengthen your reading skills with exercises in listening, basic spelling and reading practice with friends! Enjoy some games, and get help with more advanced phonics blends like silent e, vowel combinations, and word endings. This class picks up where the Learn to Read class left off and is for ages 4-8. We will be following the Phonics level 2-3 curriculum in the Academy. See their early reading skills take off after this class!



### CHESS CLUB

Chess isn't just a game; it's an essential part of an elite education, as it trains the brain to solve complex problems and think strategically and multi-dimensionally. In this club, students will play live online chess against other Blue Manor students and receive personalized lessons from chess champions. For ages 3-18.

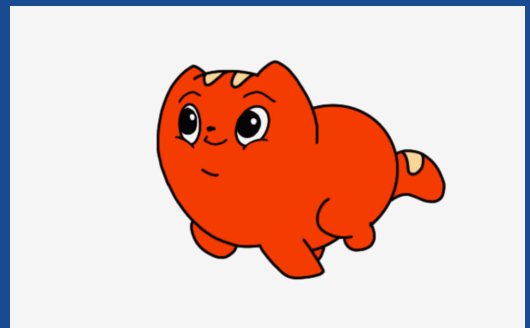
## READ ALOUD CLUB

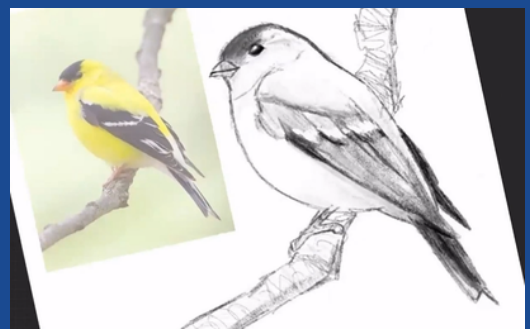
## ANIMATION CLUB

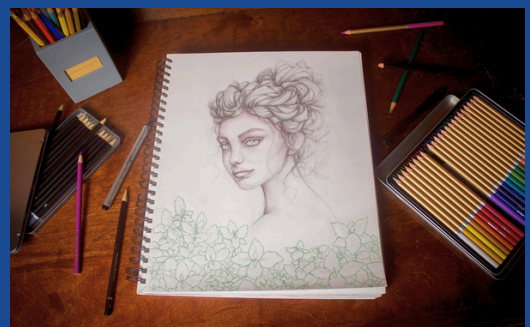
## FOUNDATIONS OF ILLUSTRATION

For all inspiring artists, to help grow their skills and bring their drawings to life in a soft, expressive illustration style. Students will begin with foundational skills such as shape, line control, and color, and progress to more complex concepts, including lighting, depth, character design, and composition. Along the way, we will explore character design, composition, and storytelling, all while building confidence through fun challenges and contests. Ages 7+

#### CODING CLUB

All coding enthusiasts are welcome, whether amateur or professional. In this club, you will have the opportunity to share your personal projects, collaborate with other students, get your questions answered, and receive brief lessons and valuable tips. Ages 7+



#### CURRENT EVENTS

In most schools, "Current Events" is the most neglected subject, with students studying in great detail all the happenings of the past, but little attention is given to what is going on in the present. This is a colossal mistake that we cannot afford to make. We want our students to hit the ground running when they graduate, and that means they must have a good understanding of the modern world they live in. This will be held once a month, and students will learn and discuss the most important issues and incidents of the previous month. Ages 7-18



#### STOCK INVESTING CLUB

In this club, students will discuss investing strategies and have the opportunity to invest fake money in the real stock market. Each student will be given 5,000 fake dollars to invest, and then students will compete to see who can make the most money in six months. Ages 7-18



#### ORATION CLUB

This club will have a 15-minute lesson, and then the rest of the hour will be dedicated to practical oration exercises. Ages 7-18

## TABLE TOPICS CLUB

If you sign up for this club, you WILL be speaking. The only items the student(s) need to bring are a piece of paper and a pencil or pen. If you are called upon to speak, you will have a maximum of two minutes to speak. The debate we will be conducting is an exercise we have used in the past to prepare for one. If you are shy but want to work on your speaking skills, this is just the thing for you. Ages 10+



## 3D MODELING CLUB

Join the 3D Modeling & Printing Club and turn your imagination into real creations! Whether you dream of designing custom keychains, cool gadgets, or models for science projects, this is your chance to learn cutting-edge skills while having fun. We'll teach you how to use beginner-friendly design software for modeling and how to print your creations. Ages 10+



## WRITING CLUB

This club is where young writers can come to create, share, and refine their work. Students will share their writing with the group and receive helpful writing tips and feedback. Writers will also have the exciting opportunity to have their work published through Blue Manor Academy. Ages 10+



## RUSSIA: REIGN & REVOLUTION

Students will learn the true history of the Russian Revolution, and uncover the cultural and social impact of secular communism as it confiscates private property, dismembers the family, and makes war on the Christian church. One of the most important classes your children will ever take because the revolution did not begin or end in Russia, and its fallout continues to impact us today. (Parental Warning): This is a very dark time in history. There was a lot of violence, and we will be discussing some of those topics. Please keep this in mind. Ages 10+

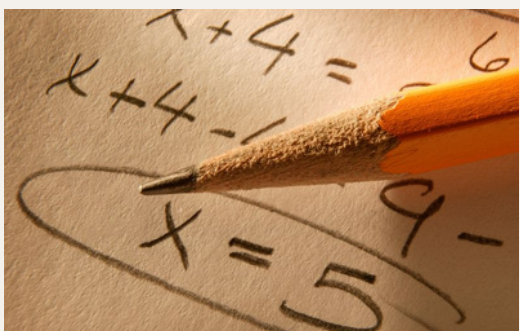

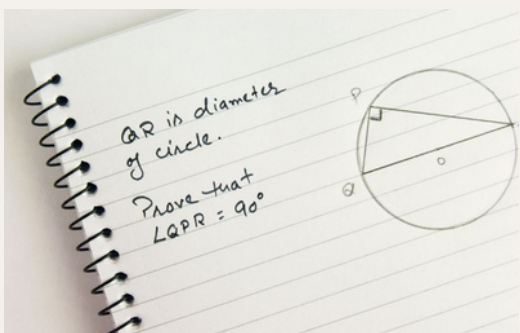
## ELEMENTARY MATH (1ST-3RD GRADE)

Designed for students in grades 1–3, this class uses Ray's Arithmetic to develop fluency in addition, subtraction, notation, and multiplication. Students will work through carefully sequenced lessons, practice mental calculation, and apply their skills to practical problems. Prerequisites: Basic knowledge of numbers and having the ability to write numbers. Class Materials (strongly recommended): a stylus or "pen" to write with during the Zoom class.



## ALGEBRA (RAY'S PRE-ALGEBRA - ALGEBRA II)

This progressive class begins with pre-algebra, giving students a firm foundation in variables, equations, exponents, and other essential concepts. Students will then advance through Algebra I and continue into Algebra II, developing increasingly sophisticated skills in solving equations, working with functions, graphing, and applying algebraic reasoning to complex problems. Class Materials (strongly recommended): a stylus or "pen" to write with during the Zoom class.



## GEOMETRY (RAY'S GEOMETRY I - TRIGONOMETRY)

This advanced mathematics course begins with Ray's Geometry I, where students will study fundamental principles of lines, angles, shapes, measurements, and geometric proofs. They will then progress through Geometry II and into trigonometry, learning to solve more complex problems involving triangles, circles, ratios, and spatial relationships. Each stage builds upon the last, preparing students for higher-level mathematical study. Prerequisites: Knowledge and some proficiency in Algebra. Class Materials (strongly recommended): a stylus or "pen" to write with during the Zoom class.

#### MATH: INTERMEDIATE (4TH-7TH GRADES)

This class uses the classical Ray's Arithmetic curriculum to advance their understanding of division, factoring, compound numbers, decimals, and fractions. Students will strengthen their computational skills, learn to approach multi-step problems with confidence, and develop the accuracy and reasoning needed for more advanced mathematics. Prerequisites: Multiplication facts are known and there is a level of comfort with multiplication overall.



#### MATH: EARLY FOUNDATIONS (PREK-K)

In this engaging PreK–Kindergarten math class, young learners will build a strong foundation through games, hands-on activities, and guided practice. Students will learn to recognize and write numbers, identify common shapes, count to 100, and solve simple addition and subtraction problems. Each lesson is designed to make early math enjoyable while strengthening confidence, number sense, and problem-solving skills.



#### MANNERS & ETIQUETTE: THE RULES OF RESPECTABILITY

Those who study and practice manners and etiquette learn not merely to memorize rules, but to move naturally and respectably through every social situation, putting others at ease while carrying themselves with confidence. Because they understand how to speak, listen, dress, respond, and behave appropriately, they appear noble, trustworthy, and capable. In this class, students will study the history, principles, and practices of good manners and proper etiquette in the home, in public, and in formal social settings.



#### LEARN TO SPELL

This elementary spelling class teaches students in Kindergarten through 2nd grade the basic rules and principles of spelling. Through guided practice and word study, students will learn common spelling patterns, letter sounds, and strategies for spelling words correctly.



#### PHOTOGRAPHY CLASS

This beginning photography class introduces students to the foundations of taking clear, creative, and well-composed photographs. Students will learn how to use basic camera settings, work with natural light, choose strong angles, frame a subject, and create balanced compositions. Through fun challenges, students will develop confidence behind the camera and begin telling meaningful stories through their photographs. No previous photography experience is required.





## CREATIVE WRITING: TRACING THE MASTERS

Most artists begin their training by attempting to recreate the great works of masters like Michelangelo and Leonardo da Vinci. Yet, when it comes to writing, the masters are often forgotten, and students receive the bulk of their instruction from grammar textbooks and English teachers. It is no wonder then that so few great literary works have been written in the last 70 years, and so many modern authors are afraid of being replaced by Grammarly and ChatGPT.

In this class, students will study and emulate the great literary masters, examining how they use language, imagery, dialogue, characterization, and structure. Through close reading, imitation exercises, and original writing, students will learn to create vivid descriptions, memorable characters, powerful sentences, compelling scenes, and memorable dialogue.
